### Background

- Deuteronomy 1-33 was penned by Moses. Chapter 34 was likely penned by Joshua.
- "Deutero" means "second." "Nomos" means "law." It is the "second law."
- Takes place in the fields of Moab on the border of the Promised Land.
- Primarily consists of three sermons preached by Moses over a period of thirty days (1:3; 34:8) (Josh. 4:19).
- Is quoted more than ninety times in the New Testament. The Lord Jesus quoted from it more than any book.
