Background

- The name "Genesis" comes from the Greek translation of the Hebrew Bible. It means "Beginning."
- Genesis was penned by Moses (Luke 24:44) (John 5:45-47).
- It is the first of the five books of the Law.
- Genesis covers roughly 2300 years of history.
- The story unfolds in three places: the fertile crescent (1-11), Israel (12-38), and Egypt (39-50).
