- Exodus was penned by Moses (Mark 12:26).
- The name "Exodus" means "the way out." The English title comes from the Greek translation of the Hebrew Scriptures (Ex. 6:6) (Ex. 12:40-43).
- The story unfolds in three places: Egypt (1-15), the wilderness (16-18), and Mt. Sinai (19-40).
